


Management of Hypertension in Primary Care

Course overview

This course is suitable for doctors, nurses and other health care professionals aiming to acquire specialised skills and qualifications in hypertension management within primary and community care; for example covering dimensions required for the NHS Knowledge and Skills Framework or accreditation for GP/PwSI.

It is aimed at providing you, a health care professional, with skills and academic requirements for specialist clinical practice within the community as well as research skills and health service evaluation.

The course is unique in that it combines both academic and clinical aspects of community and primary care with practical sessions and summative assessment in practice by trained clinical assessors. As such it would provide a clinically applicable higher level of academic achievement.

A variety of methods are deployed for teaching and learning including didactic sessions (though these are kept to a minimum); small group to individual learning; as well as sessions within the clinical field.

DAY 1 Update on management of Hypertension for GPs, nurses and other health care professionals

DAY 2 Hypertension update: Management of special groups within primary care

DAY 3 Practical management of Hypertension in primary care
