VENUE

The meeting will be held in the Cavonius Centre, Stephen Hawking Building, Gonville & Caius College, Cambridge CB2 1TA Tel 01223 332418. The College has two sites in Cambridge; the Masterclass will be held at the **West Road Site**. Directional maps will be sent to delegates two weeks before the meeting.

- By Bus: There is a frequent express service from London and surrounding airports. Timetable details are available from Stagecoach 01221 423578, National Express 08705 808080 or Traveline 08706 082608. The College West Road Site is a short taxi ride from the bus station in Drummer Street
- By Rail: A ten minute taxi journey from Cambridge Station will cost around £6. There are no buses to the college from the station.
- By Car: Cars are not encouraged in Cambridge and delegates are strongly advised to either travel by public transport or to use one of the many Park and Ride sites around the city.
